Provider Description:

ATS offers a free, computer-based tutoring program to students in grades K–12 for Reading/Writing or Math. Each student in our program receives at least 30 hours of tutoring. Our tutoring program includes: * A pre-test before tutoring starts to determine each student’s needs. * A post-test at the end of the tutoring program to compare to the pre-test; this shows us the growth the student has made during the program. *Monthly progress reports for parents, school teachers, and the school district. Progress reports are available in parents’ native language. *A learning plan customized for each student's learning needs. **LOCATION:** Students receive one-to-one tutoring in the comfort and convenience of their home. In-home tutoring allows students to learn in a confidential setting, avoiding any embarrassment they may feel in a tradition tutoring setting. Our tutors monitor sessions remotely and are available by phone to help students. **WHEN:** We offer tutoring before school, after school, on weekends, during holidays, and in the summer. Our tutors work closely with families to arrange tutoring times that are convenient for them. **COMPUTER-BASED CURRICULUM:** We provide students with all of the learning tools they need to access our program. Our engaging, research-based curriculum is published by Pearson and Compass Learning. Students are able to access the curriculum 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We provide Internet access for students whose home has at least a landline. We provide an Internet router to our students so they can connect to existing Internet, if needed. **HIGH-QUALITY TUTORS:** All ATS tutors have at least a bachelor’s degree. Most of our tutors are state-certified teachers. **SUCCESS RATES:** Our program has a high rate of success increasing our students’ academic scores on statewide assessments, as well as in their classrooms. * In the **2010-11 school year**, our grade K-8 students achieved an average grade level gain of 1.23 in Reading/Writing and 0.97 in Math. Our grade 9-12 students achieved an average growth of 100.59% in Reading/Writing and 103.33% in Math. * In the **2009-10 school year**, our grade K-8 students achieved an average grade level gain of 1.33 in Reading/Writing and 1.15 in Math. * In a recent **parent survey:** 100% of parents said they were satisfied with the overall quality of our program, 91.9% of parents reported improvement in student attitude toward school, 93% of parents report an improvement in student grades as a result of participating in our program, and 97.7% of parents report that they would sign up their child with ATS again.
